POSITION DESCRIPTION:

The Wave Lifeguard/ Operator are responsible for ensuring the safety of facility patrons by preventing and responding to emergency situations on the all waves. Wave Operators also ensure a great rider experience for customers on the waves.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Be able to obtain or currently have the proper certifications
- Be able to work in the elements everyday
- Be able to lift up to 50lbs
- Be able to work days, nights, weekends and holidays
- Be able to produce contact info for at least three references who are familiar with your work

The following certifications are required after hire:

1. American Red Cross Lifeguard Training/First Aid (or equivalent training).
2. American Red Cross CPR for the Professional Rescuer (or equivalent training).
3. American Red Cross First Aid for Public Safety Personnel (or equivalent training).
4. Pre-employment performance testing of lifeguarding skills and knowledge

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Effectively supervise the assigned area(s) of responsibility including all waves by monitoring the activities of our riders.
- Instruct all new and beginner customers on how to ride the waves.
- Project and promote a professional image and a fun atmosphere at all times.
- Prevent injuries by minimizing or eliminating hazardous situations or behaviors on all waves.
- Enforce facility rules and regulations and educate patrons about them, as needed.
- Recognize and respond effectively to all emergencies using proper techniques. This may mean performing water rescues, using CPR, first aid, oxygen or an automated external defibrillator, if needed and only if trained.
- Maintain current certifications and physical fitness.
- Maintain proper water chemistry, by conducting routine chemical testing of the water on an hourly basis.
- Perform routine maintenance duties to identified facility areas on a regularly scheduled basis.
- Complete additional duties as assigned by supervisor.
